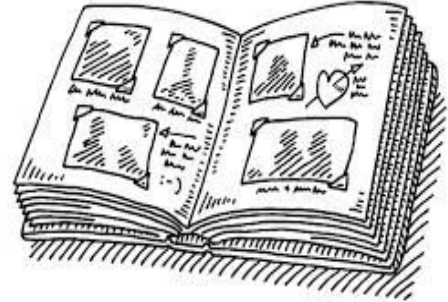

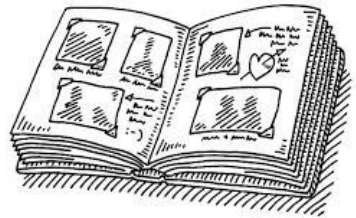


 To prepare for this task you should

- **describe the features of your identity in short descriptive paragraphs like the ones you wrote in class (similar length and structure).**

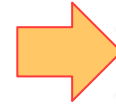
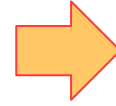

- Also include space to write the paragraphs next to each photo.

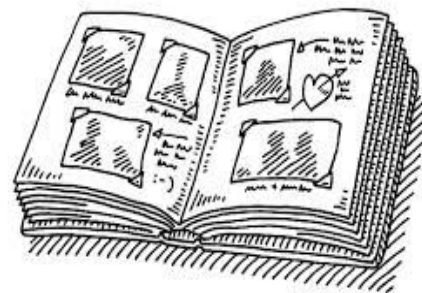


Task 1 instructions, tips, Q & A (15')

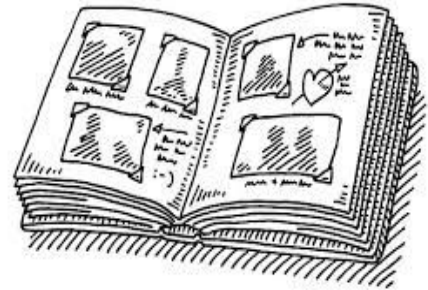
